

2023 Arizcuren • Barranco del Prado • James Suckling**95**_{/100}

Bright and racy nose of wild berries, red plums, hibiscus, minerals and a peppery twist. Medium- to full-bodied with superb, mineral-etched tannins that are firm and easily dissolved. Pristine and quite long. Drink or hold.

2023 Arizcuren • Finca el Foro • James Suckling**94**_{/100}

Racy and ethereal nose of wild raspberries, grapefruit, botanicals and cracked peppercorns with a nervy, peppery twist. Quite pristine and medium-bodied, with a stony, spicy core without too much fruit. Long finish. This really shows a sense of place without fruit or oak marring it. Delicious now, but can hold.

2023 Arizcuren • Solomazuelo • James Suckling**93**_{/100}

Aromas of damp earth, violets and wild dark berries and cherries. Really attractive, with a nicely funky, peppery twist to the fruit. Medium- to full-bodied with a very calm, composed center palate. Tannins are really fine grained. Drink or hold.

2023 Arizcuren • Sologarnacha • James Suckling**93**_{/100}

Aromas of racy strawberries, grapefruit, minerals and red berries. Fine, mineral-etched tannins are quite dusty. This is really elegant and refined, with a long, supple finish. Infusion style. Hard to resist now.

2022 Arizcuren • Apunte n°9 • James Suckling**93**_{/100}

A very serious rosado made from Garnacha and Mazuelo. Bright, medium salmon hue, with integrated toast, subtle minerals and flinty fruit. Elegant and refined, with very good volume and length. Drink or hold. Only 900 bottles.

2023 Arizcuren • Monte Gatún • James Suckling**91**_{/100}

A fruity, expressive nose of ripe cherries, baked plums, grapefruit and hibiscus. Juicy and vivid, with a medium body and some firm, chalky tannins. Pristine and bright in the finish. Drink now.
